1 family was provided safe shelter at Children's Inn when fleeing from a domestic abuse situation

58 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

8 children were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

2 families received furniture through the Furniture Mission

3 girls participated in scouting

4 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

3 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

16 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

1 senior was matched with another senior through the Senior Companions Program

3 individuals with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services

2 children were provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
