3 families were provided safe shelter at Children's Inn when fleeing from a domestic abuse situation

4 families were able to stay in their homes through assistance from Community Outreach

53 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

2 people received counseling through Family Service

8 children were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

1 family received furniture through the Furniture Mission

7 girls participated in scouting

11 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

5 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

1 individual was partnered with a volunteer to learn to read through the Literacy Council

20 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

22 children were provided with nutritious, easy-to-prepare foods for the weekend through the BackPack Program.

18 families received assistance through the Salvation Army

1 adult or child who was the victim of sexual assault or domestic violence received support services through The Compass Center.

1 individuals with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services

1 child was provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
