**1 family** was able to stay in their home through assistance from Community Outreach

**90 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

**6 children** were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

**1 family** received furniture through the Furniture Mission

**6 girls** participated in scouting

**32 individuals** received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

**25 youth** were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

**1 individual** was partnered with a volunteer to learn to read through the Literacy Council

**11 families** utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

**22 children** were provided with nutritious, easy-to-prepare foods for the weekend through the Backpack Program.

**14 families** received assistance through the Salvation Army

**4 adults and children** who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.
