13 children received a supportive adult role model through Big Brothers Big Sisters

574 boys participated in Boy Scouts

554 students participated in a Life/Skills Training program through Carroll Institute's Project Awareness

2 children were provided a volunteer advocate, who served on the child's behalf through the overburdened juvenile court system through Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA)

35 seniors were provided nutritional meals in their homes allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Meals on Wheels

240 children were given the opportunity to participate in Character Counts!, a youth development opportunity

2 families were provided safe shelter at Children's Inn when fleeing from a domestic abuse situation

3 families were able to stay in their homes through assistance from Community Outreach

1 child was provided safe after-school care through Dell Rapids Community Haven

62 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

76 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

9 people received counseling through Family Service

13 children were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

4 families received furniture through the Furniture Mission

37 girls participated in scouting

9 youth received educational, musical, cultural and creative opportunities at the Bowden Youth Center

1 disabled child was provided with after-school and summer care through Here4Youth

11 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

13 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

1 individual with disabilities or an at-risk youth received therapeutic horseback riding, hippotherapy and/or counseling services through Handi-Riders.

17 seniors were matched with volunteer opportunities in various non-profit agencies through RSVP

1 senior was matched with another senior through the Senior Companions Program

7 adults and children who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.

41 families received assistance through the Salvation Army

2 individuals with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services

12 children were provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
