6 families were provided safe shelter at Children's Inn when fleeing from a domestic abuse situation

5 families were able to stay in their homes through assistance from Community Outreach

47 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

3 people received counseling through Family Service

3 families received furniture through the Furniture Mission

9 girls participated in scouting

19 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

8 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

2 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

54 children were provided with nutritious, easy-to-prepare foods for the weekend through the BackPack Program.
