**3 individuals** were given the opportunity to communicate with members of their families who are in the Armed Forces through American Red Cross.

**9 children** received a supportive adult role model through Big Brothers Big Sisters

**81 boys** participated in Boy Scouts

**350 students** participated in a Life/Skills Training program through Carroll Institute's Project Awareness

**190 seniors** were provided nutritional meals in their homes allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Meals on Wheels

**673 children** were given the opportunity to participate in Character Counts!, a youth development opportunity

**3 families** were able to stay in their homes through assistance from Community Outreach

**141 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

**1 expectant mother** with limited resources received home visits from nurses during pregnancy and after delivery through the BrightStart Program.

**7 people** received counseling through Family Service

**8 children** were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

**10 families** received furniture through the Furniture Mission

**41 girls** participated in scouting

**12 youth** received educational, musical, cultural and creative opportunities at the Bowden Youth Center

**25 individuals** received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

**4 disabled children** were provided with after-school and summer care through Here4Youth

**22 youth** were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

**31 families** utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

**2 individuals with disabilities** and at-risk youth received therapeutic horseback riding, hippotherapy and/or counseling services through Handi-Riders.

**34 seniors** were matched with volunteer opportunities in various non-profit agencies through RSVP

**23 families** received assistance through the Salvation Army

**2 seniors** were matched with another senior through the Senior Companions Program

**4 adults and children** who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.

**6 children** were provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
