3 children were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

3 families received furniture through the Furniture Mission

3 youth received educational, musical, cultural and creative opportunities at the Bowden Youth Center

5 girls participated in scouting

14 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

7 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

16 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

5 families received assistance through the Salvation Army

1 senior was matched with another senior through the Senior Companions Program

2 adults and children who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.

4 individuals with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services

2 children were provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
