**1 individual** was given the opportunity to communicate with members of their family who are in the Armed Forces through American Red Cross.

**32 boys** participated in Boy Scouts

**375 students** participated in a Life/Skills Training program through Carroll Institute's Project Awareness

**53 seniors** were provided nutritional meals in their homes allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Meals on Wheels

**82 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

**2 people** received counseling through Family Service

**3 children** were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

**18 girls** participated in scouting

**1 family** received furniture through the Furniture Mission

**14 individuals** received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

**1 disabled children** were provided with after-school and summer care through Here4Youth

**2 youth** were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

**1 individual** was partnered with a volunteer to learn to read through the Literacy Council

**17 families** utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

**5 families** received assistance through the Salvation Army

**4 individuals** with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services
