84 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month

11 people received counseling through Family Service

8 children were able to visit with family members in a safe, supervised atmosphere at the Family Visitation Center

7 girls participated in scouting

8 individuals received referral information through the HelpLine Center's 211

1 disabled child was provided with after-school and summer care through Here4Youth

13 youth were given the opportunity to play basketball through the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

28 families utilized credit counseling, therapy and mentoring through Lutheran Social Services

7 seniors were matched with volunteer opportunities in various non-profit agencies through RSVP

3 seniors were matched with another senior through the Senior Companions Program

1 adult or child who was the victim of sexual assault or domestic violence received support services through The Compass Center.

3 individuals with limited or no financial resources received counseling through Sioux Falls Psychological Services

5 children were provided with quality summer childcare through Youth Enrichment Services
