four *individuals*

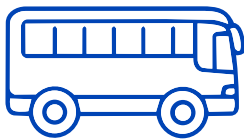
are able to participate in a painting class at DakotAbilities, practicing self-expression through art, strengthen fine motor skills, and build social connections.
