4 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 programs.

168 children were given the opportunity to participate in Character On Track, a youth development opportunity.

5 individuals received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

5 individuals utilized credit counseling through Lutheran Social Services.

1 family with children who were victims of abuse or sexual assault were provided with counseling and support through Sanford Health's Child's Voice Family Advocate.

11 new parents received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Health's Success by 6 program.

4 boys participated in Boy Scouts.

17 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month.

1 individuals were able to maintain access to psychiatric services through Southeastern Behavioral Healthcare.
