1 older adult with social, cognitive, or physical limitations was given support through Day Break.

5 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 programs.

1 juvenile offender participated in Teen Court or a Juvenile Diversion program through Boy Scouts.

28 boys participated in Boy Scouts.

1 boy that would not otherwise be involved with Boy Scouts was able to participate in traditional scouting through ScoutReach.

1 domestic violence victim was provided with immediate information and support through Children's Inn Crisis Intervention.

4 adults and children who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.

5 sexual assault victims were provided with advocacy services that included navigating court system, filing protection orders, and safety planning through The Compass Center's Victim Advocacy program.

2 children and adults learned the basics of swimming and importance of water safety through EmBe.

5 girls were inspired to be joyful, healthy and confident by participating in Girls on the Run or Heart and Sole, a fun, experience-based curriculum which integrates running.

3 youth were provided with a variety of recreational opportunities through EmBe.

3 people received counseling through Family Service.

1 family received furniture through the Furniture Mission.

1 adult transitioning from incarceration or another setting was provided with comprehensive services, preparing for employment and independent living through The Glory House's Case Management Program.

29 individuals received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

8 people were connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services Helpline Center's Network of Care.

4 individuals utilized a 24 hour hotline during a crisis or participated in suicide trainings or support groups through Helpline Center's Suicide & Crisis Support.

2 individuals received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.
