

Sioux Empire United Way Funded Agency Bingo

Once finding which agency they think is correct, employee marks off their spaces, until someone reaches Bingo.

Call List:

This agency's program provides out of school time programming to children that focuses on five core areas: the arts, education and career development, health and life skills, character and leadership skills, and sports and recreation. Last year, they served 358 students.

Answer: Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire

This program provides a one-day program that focuses on empathy skill building. Last year, the program happened in 13 different schools across the Sioux Empire.

Answer: Challenge Day

This program provides an educational framework for teaching trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship.

Answer: Character on Track

This agency's program provides weekly support groups to children whose parent or close family member has been incarcerated. Last year, 293 students participated.

Answer: Family Connection

This program provided 687 youth with a certificate to participate in an extra-curricular activity for free or at a reduced rate.

Answer: Connecting Kids

This program mails a free book to over 10,800 children each month.

Answer: Dolly Parton's Imagination Library

This agency's program had 871 girls participate in an after school character development and empowerment program at 46 different schools last year.

Answer: EmBe

This program provides a free after-school music program to 75 students.

Answer: Harmony South Dakota

This program provides a free after school and summer recreation program and serves an average of 50 children and 8 middle school students daily.

Answer: Kidstop

This agency has multiple mentoring programs, school-based, community-based, long-term for high school students, and even an opportunity for volunteers to connect with older adults for social and recreational opportunities.

Answer: Lutheran Social Services of South Dakota

This agency serves 692 students with after school and summer programming that includes reading assistance, math help, karate, and programs to recognize different cultures.

Answer: The Multi-Cultural Center of Sioux Falls

18,732 hours of community service were completed by teens through this agency's program that provides an alternative to formal court proceedings.

Answer: Boy Scouts of America, Sioux Council

This program is a free one-day dental clinic for children. Last year, 156 patients were provided with dental screenings.

Sioux Empire Smiles

This agency's after school program served 1,137 students at five middle schools last year.

Answer: Sioux Falls Family YMCA

This organization's high quality, pre-kindergarten experience serves 68 children whose families have socio-economic challenges.

Answer: Sioux Falls School District

This childcare option provided care for 134 children last year.

Answer: United Childcare and Preschool

This program provides a full array of clinical services related to speech, language and literacy.

Answer: USD Scottish Rite Children's Clinic for Speech & Language Disorders

This agency has a program that assists runaway and homeless youth through crisis intervention, on-street outreach, case management and referrals for emergency shelter. Last year, 235 individuals were provided assistance.

Answer: Volunteers of America, Dakotas

This agency has a program that provided 219,947 meals to 3,619 older adults last year.

Answer: Active Generations

This program provides social/recreational and educational activities for adults with disabilities. Last year, 159 small group, large group or one-on-one activities were held, benefitting 79 individuals with disabilities.

Answer: FriendsLink

This agency has a program that provides social and recreational opportunities to adults with disabilities. Last year, 15,360 hours of service were provided to 120 individuals.

Answer: DakotAbilities

This program utilizes the power of the horse to provide therapy to individuals with special needs.

Answer: HorsePower

This agency's program provides 2,870 children with food for the weekend.

Answer: Feeding South Dakota

This organization has a program that focuses on early intervention with children in pre-kindergarten through fifth grade. Students and their families are connected with a family health coordinator to build family connection and stability while identifying and treating the family's mental health needs.

Answer: Avera

This organization's program helps families and children in crisis by providing a network of volunteer host families who help parents who need temporary care for their children as they face unmanageable or critical circumstances. Last year, 122 children were provided safe care.

Answer: Bethany Christian Services

This organization provides immediate safe shelter for women and children fleeing abuse. Last year, 968 individuals sought shelter for a total of 17,200 shelter days.

Answer: Children's Inn

This organization provides information and referrals to local agencies and emergency financial assistance for basic needs items, including shelter, utilities, and employment related transportation.

Answer: The Community Outreach

This organization addresses the psychological, emotional, and physical effects of rape, sexual assault, and domestic violence by providing counseling services to any primary or secondary victim of sexual assault, domestic violence, and/or stalking.

Answer: The Compass Center

This organization provides a variety of counseling services including marriage and family, parent/child, alcohol/drugs, depression, anxiety, and stress. Last year, 9,316 hours of service were provided to 1,424 individuals.

Answer: Family Service, Inc.

This program receives donations of gently used furniture and distributes through social service agency referrals. Last year, 1,817 households benefitted from the program.

Answer: Furniture Mission

This organization's easy to remember phone number is a way for community members to be connected with information about and referrals to human services for every day needs and in times of crisis. Last year, 25,431 calls were answered.

Answer: Helpline Center

This agency's program provides transitional housing for homeless families and their children and served 135 families last year.

Answer: Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnership

This program provides 2,700 hours of tutoring to 170 adults in order to improve their reading, writing, and living skills.

Answer: REACH

This program was developed specifically to help children who are experiencing grief. Last year, 16 children and 11 adults participated in the program.

Answer: Sad Isn't Bad

This organization's program supports child victims of abuse and sexual assault and their non-offending family member. The advocate within this program helped 358 children and 353 non-offending family members with crisis intervention and support, attendance at interviews or case reviews, follow-up care, referrals to mental health and medical care, and other advocacy.

Answer: Sanford

This organization provided 17,110 volunteer hours last year to advocate for abused and neglected children.

Answer: Sioux Falls Area CASA Program

This agency's program assists low-income individuals and family members who are receiving housing assistance with eliminating barriers to attaining education and employment skills.

Answer: Sioux Falls Housing & Redevelopment Commission

This agency provides transitional housing and case management, serving 32 families, 22 children, and 374 single individuals last year.
