## **SEUW Funded Agencies**

Find which Sioux Empire United Way Funded Programs are identified in the below descriptions:

- "This program is designed to provide recreational and social activities for people with physical and intellectual disabilities to be an integral member of the community. Exploration of interests and improved communication through art, music, theatre, health, and wellness."
- "This program supports youth and families by giving students a safe, supervised, educational and engaging environment during afterschool and summer hours. Programming is focused on the core areas of the Arts & STEM, Education and Career Development, Healthy Lifestyles, Character and Leadership, and Sports & Recreation. The Club serves children 6-18 years of age with transportation available from most elementary and middle schools."
- "This program focuses on helping children, with an incarcerated loved one, who often suffer even more than other family members. As part of this unique prevention program, children with a family member in prison come together to share their feelings. Children acquire the skills to cope with the family member's absence, build their self-esteem and learn to make positive choices."
- "This program is a community grief support program for children and parents/caregivers."
- "This program provides social and health services for adults who need supervised care in a safe place outside the home during the day."
