- 23 older adults were provided nutritional meals in their homes or in a congregate dining setting, allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Active Generations' Meals on Wheels program.
- 3 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assesments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.
- 2 youth received quality childcare and educational programs through Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire's Early Childhood Education.
- 1 vulnerable adult and financially limited person was assisted with family law issues such as protection orders, custody/visitation or divorce through East River Legal Services.
- **7 individuals** received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.
- **5 people** were connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services Helpline Center's Network of Care.

- **1 individual** received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.
- 6 new parents received information about their child's development and tempermament through Sanford Childrens' Success by 6 program.
- **35 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month.
- **1 family** received one-time financial assistance for basic needs through Community Outreach.
- **1 adult and child** who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence receive support services through The Compass Center.
- 1 child received evaluation and treatment for communication disorders through USD Scottish Rite Children's Clinic.
