31 older adults were provided nutritional meals in their homes or in a congregate dining setting, allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Active Generations' Meals on Wheels program.

2 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

1 expectant mother with limited resources received home visits from nurses during pregnancy and after delivery through Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety's BrightStart Program.

4 individuals received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

1 person was connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services Helpline Center's Network of Care.

1 individual and family was provided with financial support and resources after losing a

loved one to suicide through Lost&Found's Survivors Joining for Hope program.

8 new parents received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Children's Success by 6 program.

6 youth participated in Scouting America which helps to build self-confidence, develops leadership and decision making in youth.

19 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month.
