5 older adults were provided nutritional meals in their homes or in a congregate dining setting, allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Active Generations' Meals on Wheels program.

2 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

2 youths attended a safe, supervised, and engaged place that focuses on arts, education, and career development, health and life skills, character and leadership skills, and sports and recreation through Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire's K-5 program.

1 person received counseling through Family Service.

9 individuals received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

1 person was connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services through Helpline Center's Network of Care.

1 individual received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.

2 individuals received financial counseling, debt management, financial education, student loan counseling, credit report consultations and bankruptcy counseling through Lutheran Social Services' Center for Financial Resources.

1 youth was provided with an adult mentor to establish a trusting relationship through LSS's In School Mentoring program.

8 new parents received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Children's Success by 6 program.

31 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a free book each month.
