- 21 older adults were provided nutritional meals in their homes or in a congregate dining setting, allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Active Generations.
- 2 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 programs.
- 11 boys participated in Boy Scouts.
- **2 youths** attended a safe, supervised, and engaged place that focuses on arts, education, and career development, health and life skills, character and leadership skills, and sports and recreation through Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire's Empower Club.
- **24 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month.
- **1 family** received furniture through the Furniture Mission.
- **2 individuals** received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.
- **1 individual** utilized credit counseling through Lutheran Social Services.
- 2 adults who had committed domestic violence were provided with therapy groups that taught safe and healthy relationship skills through Lutheran Social Services' Family Violence Project.

- **3 students** were provided professional mental health counseling sessions directly in their school through PATH.
- 1 new parent received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Health's Success by 6 program.
