- **1 older adult** with social, cognitive, or physical limitations was given support through Active Generations' Day Break.
- **64 new parents** received resource booklets, temperament assesments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.
- 2 domestic violence victims were provided with immediate information and support through Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety's Crisis Intervention.
- 10 individuals were provided access to naloxone and fentanyl test strips free of charge from Emily's Hope.
- **7 families** received furniture through the Furniture Mission.
- **3 individuals** received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.

- **4 youth** were provided with an adult mentor to establish a trusting relationship through LSS's In School Mentoring program.
- **75 children** participated in Scouting America which helps to build self-confidence, develops leadership and decision making in youth.
