**3 care givers** of adult loved ones were provided with assistance, education, and support through Active Generations' CAREgivers program.

**1 older adult** with social, cognitive, or physical limitations was given support through Active Generations' Day Break.

**64 new parents** received resource booklets, temperament assesments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

**14 people** received counseling through Family Service.

3 individuals received financial counseling, debt management, financial education, student loan counseling, credit report consultations and bankruptcy counseling through Lutheran Social Services' Center for Financial Resources.

**4 youths** were provided with an adult mentor to establish a trusting relationship through LSS's In School Mentoring program.

**76 new parents** received information about their child's development and tempermament through Sanford Childrens' Success by 6 program.

34 boys participated in Boy Scouts.

**503 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a free book each month.

**2 adults and children** who were victims of sexual assault or domestic violence received support services through The Compass Center.

1 sexual assault victim was provided with advocacy services that included navigating court system, filing protection orders, and safety planning through The Compass Center's Victim Advocacy program.
