**1 care giver** of adult loved ones was provided with assistance, education, and support through Active Generations' CAREgivers program.

**6 new parents** received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

**2 vulnerable adults and financially limited people** were assisted with family law issues such as protection orders, custody/visitation or divorce through East River Legal Services.

**2 families** received furniture through the Furniture Mission.

**16 individuals** received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

**3 people** were connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services Helpline Center's Network of Care.

**2 youth** were provided with an adult mentor to establish a trusting relationship through LSS's In School Mentoring program.

**1 family** with children who were victims of abuse or sexual assault was provided with counseling and support through Sanford Health's Child's Voice Family Advocate.

**5 new parents** received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Children's Success by 6 program.

**1 child** participated in Scouting America which helps to build self-confidence, develops leadership and decision making in youth.

**34 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a book each month.
